

Guidelines for the preparation of national communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention

The Conference of the Parties,

Recalling, in particular, Article 4, paragraphs 1, 3 and 7, Article 10, paragraph 2(a) and Article 12, paragraphs 1, 5 and 7, of the Convertion,

Recalling also is decisions on communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (non-Annex I Parties) and, in particular, its decisions 10/CP.2, 2/CP.4, 12/CP.4, 8/CP.5, 31/CP.7 and 32/CP.7,

Recalling further that, by its decision 8/CP.5, it had initiated a process of reviewing the guidelines for the preparation of national communications from non-Annex I Parties, with the aim of improving them,

Having in wind that, at its seventh session, it had decided¹ to continue the process of reviewing the guidelines for the preparation of national communications from non-Armer I Parties, with a view to adopting them at its righth session,

Acknowledging that the Consultative Group of Experts on National Communications from Parties not included in Arnex 11 to the Convention has made important contributions to the revision of the guidelines, for the preparation of national communications from non-Annex 1 Parties,

1. Decider


(a) That Parties not included in Annex I to the Convertion (non-Annex I Parties) should use the guidelines contained in the annex to this decision for the preparation of second and, where appropriate, third national communications and, where appropriate, initial rutient corresponding. 


Decision 8/CP.11

- Invites NAIP to prepare project proposals, even in advance of substantially completing their previous NCs, in order to avoid a lack of continuity in project financing
- Decides that NAIP should apply for the financing of their subsequent NCs at any time between 3 to 5 years of the initial disbursement of funds for the actual preparation of their previous NCs
- Shall make all efforts to submit their 2nd NC (or when appropriate 3rd) within 4 years of the disbursement of financial resources
- May use an extension of up to 1 year (after having informed the secretariat), but this shall not imply additional financial resources




Status of submission of Initial (INCs) and Second National Communications (SNCs) projected submissions of SNC


Projected Regional Distribution of Second National Communications (2010-2012)


