# Language

All presenters are expected to use English.

# **Presentation Time**

Each presenter is allocated 15 minutes (12 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for Q&A). The time allotted for each presentation will be strictly observed.

The timekeeper will use bell sounds to signal the remaining time. The bell will ring as follows:

Once at 10 <sup>th</sup> minutes:	Two more minutes left for the presentation.
Twice at 12 <sup>th</sup> minutes:	End of the presentation and start of Q&A
Three times at 15 <sup>th</sup> minutes:	End of Q&A

#### NOTE

• Please be seated at the speaker's standby seat placed at the front of the room when the speaker ahead of you begins the presentation.

#### Equipment

Projection: Only single projection is available.

PC: Please use the laptop PC prepared in the session room, on which each presenter's presentation materials is uploaded by the secretariat in advance. The PC will run on Windows 7 with Microsoft Office PowerPoint 2010 and Adobe Acrobat Reader.

#### NOTE

• Basically, presentations from own personal laptops are NOT allowed to ensure smooth running of the workshop.
